

## **Fort Atkinson Loop – 51 miles**

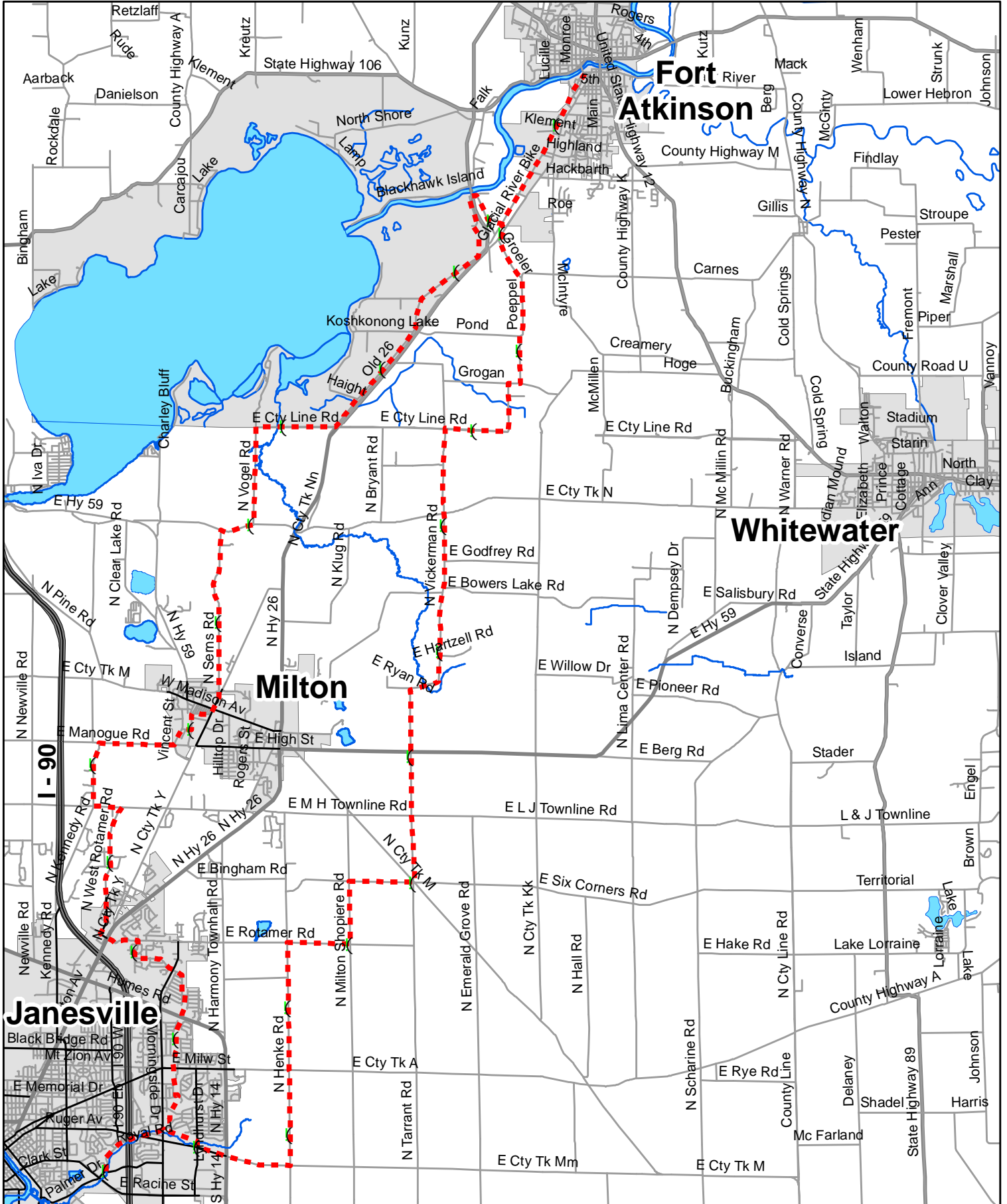
No traffic; that describes this frequent Saturday morning route into Fort Atkinson. The route has a good sized hill on Vickerman Road just north of County N. Entry and leaving Fort Atkinson is done using the Glacial River Bike Trail, a paved path starting downtown Fort Atkinson and heading south to Old 26. Coupled with town roads, this route is made for those seeking to avoid traffic.

One of our favorite breakfast stops in on the south side of Fort, when on the bike path let your nose find or look for the sewage plant. At that intersection turn east (right) on the cross street (Farmco Lane), cut through the gas station and Ford dealership to the Fort Atkinson Family Restaurant.

Our return is through Milton; take some time to visit the community. It was originally two villages; Milton and Milton Junction. They merged in the 60's. Rumor has it the merger was over a garbage truck, and the ability to secure some federal dollars if the population was larger. The former Milton College campus is a very pretty location and the famous Milton House Museum has just completed an extensive renovation and expansion. Ice cream is available on Madison Avenue west.
